

## Year 5 Spring 2 Curriculum

### Maths:

At the start of the half term, we be learning about negative numbers . We will then progress onto how to interpret statistics, by reading line graphs and timetables.

After that, we will be looking at the properties of 3D shapes and estimating volume.

### Computing

We will be learning how to create a quiz on scratch. Children will create their own avatar in this introduction to coding.

### PSHE

We will start the term by looking at 'All unique, all equal'.

We will discuss our similarities and differences and what makes us unique. We are exploring diversity in the UK and challenging our views on stereotypes.

### Music

We will be learning about Jazz music. We will learn to play pieces without notation and from memory, just like many jazz musicians do!

### Guided Reading:

Our Guided Reading text is 'How to Spaghettify your dog'. We will be solidifying our skills of retrieval and summarisation.

### PE:

PE will be on **Wednesday** this half term where we will be working on fitness and learning how to play tag rugby.

### Topic - Science:

In science we will be investigating states of matter. We will be exploring the properties of matter and describing how particles move. We will then look at reversible and irreversible changes.
