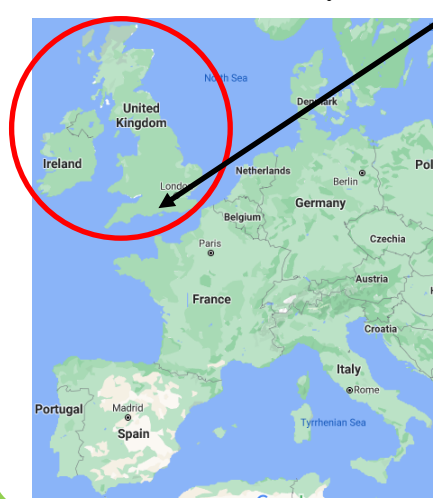

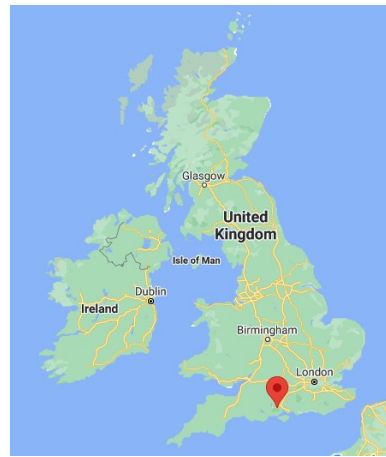

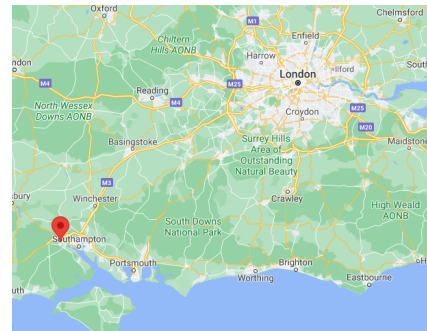
Calmore is in **Europe**, because it is in the **United Kingdom, England**.

It is located in the **south of England** and is lower than the capital city of London.

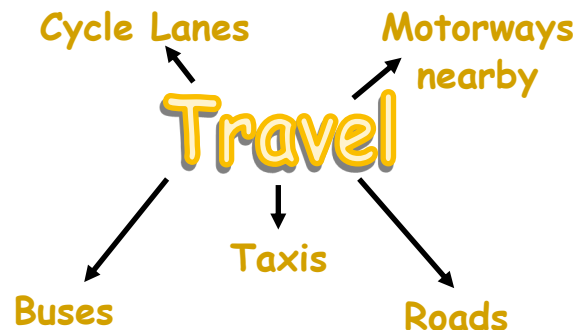


Calmore is a relatively small **suburban residential area** which is situated just outside of Southampton. It is in the county of **Hampshire**.
