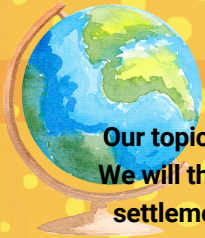
COMPUTING

GEOGRAPHY

We will also investigate the continent of Europe, specifically France and comparing the city of Paris with our own capital city London. We will be using maps and developing using geographical language.
