



## MATHS

Autumn 1 will begin with understanding the place value of numbers up to 10,000,000. This will include rounding numbers. We will also develop our understanding of mental and written strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be using all 4 operations to solve multi-step problems.

## COMPUTING

This term, we will learn about the World Wide Web as a communication tool. We will learn how we find information on the World Wide Web using search engines. We will then focus on internet-based communication.



## HISTORY

Our topic name this term is 'It's All Greek To Me!' We will be learning about the legacy the Greeks have left behind, including politics, language, architecture, sport (specifically the Greek Olympics), ideas & beliefs and knowledge.



## ART

In art, we will be creating Greek bowls based on the iconic designs of the Ancient Greek era. We will be comparing the work of Trevor Baird, who is an artist who creates contemporary designs on vases, to the Greek pots that have been found in excavations.

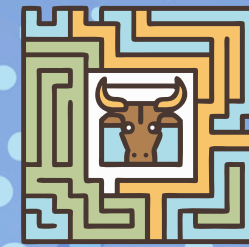
## Thursday 23rd October
