2. ELECTRIC SCOOTERS

Yesterday, we had an incident in the playground where a child was riding around on an electric scooter. In Hampshire, it is illegal to ride privately owned electric scooters on public roads, pavements, or public spaces, including on school journeys. While manual scooters are encouraged through My Journey Hampshire initiatives, e-scooters are classified as motor vehicles, requiring insurance that is generally unavailable, risking seizure and fines.

Therefore, electric scooters are not permitted on the school site. We thank you for your co-operation with this.
