1. THIS WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS: Athletics and more athletics...

It's been a busy week in the world of sport here at school. As well as our Calmore World Cup kicking off, 40 children from across the school took part in two athletics competitions. On Tuesday, 24 Year 3 and Year 4 pupils set off to Testwood with Miss Ingram and Mrs Bowers to take part in Quadkids. As the name suggests, each child participated in four events - vortex, long jump, 50m sprint and 400m. The children were fantastic with each of them giving their all in every event. As well as competing brilliantly, they supported each other so well, especially when it got tough for some. Well done Year 3 and Year 4 - you were superb!



Yesterday, two teams of Year 5 and Year 6 pupils competed in the Athletics Championships on the track at Southampton Sports Centre. The venue is a special one and meant the children got to tread in the footsteps of former GB Olympic medalists such as Iwan Thomas, Kriss Akabusi and Roger Black who all trained there. Our own athletes continued that impressive run, setting individual, year group and whole school records along the way. Josh and Sapphire both broke the school 600m record; Amy broke the school 80m and Y5 triple jump records; Zach broke the Y6 triple jump record. Both Logan and Thomas also came close to breaking their own vortex and long jump records respectively...though, along with Zach and Josh, they were part of the boys' 4x100m team who broke that school record later! Bella not only broke the Y5 150m record but smashed the school vortex record coming third overall and in doing so claimed bronze. Wow! Once again, each pupil gave it everything and should be so proud of their efforts. Whilst being a team event, it is very much an individual sport where you have to push yourself to the limit in order to achieve your very best. We are always in awe and admiration of each and every one of you. Well done on another great day!
