

Year 3 Autumn 1 Curriculum

MATHS

We have started off the year with counting and place value. We will be moving onto addition and subtraction. We will finish up the term with multiplication and division.

After half term we will be learning our times tables and sending these home for the children to practise.

COMPUTING

We will be learning how to describe what an input is and explain how a computer network can be used to share information.

We will also be practising keyboard skills on the BBC Dance Mat program.

GEOGRAPHY

Our topic name this term is 'Where on Earth are we?' We are going to be researching our local area and taking a trip around Calmore. We will then create a map using our own symbols to show our route. We will be learning about the UK, its countries and cities. We will also investigate the continent of Europe, specifically France.

ART

In Art we will be studying the work of Phillip Dujardin and Zaha Hadid who focus on architecture. We will be creating our own houses using a variety of line, collage and print techniques.

GUIDED READING

Our Guided Reading book will be 'I'll Take You to Mrs Cole'. We will be reading this book together and following it up with a variety of reading activities.

FRENCH

Getting to Know You

Lessons will include how to greet each other, asking people their name and how old they are, counting from 0 - 10.

PSHE

We have started the year off by looking at the school rules and why they are important. We have introduced children to the rewards of positive behaviours and also the learning behaviours which make up and are a very important part of our teaching and learning approach here at Calmore Junior School.

ENTRY POINT

We will be walking on a circular route around Calmore to identify the features of where we live. This will enable us to draw a map using symbols.

ENGLISH

RE:
