Road Safety

One of the key road safety messages is about every vehicle occupant being safe and from various sessions with primary and secondary aged pupils, we are discovering that not all young people understand the importance of wearing seatbelts and using car seats when necessary. With this in mind, and with an increase in the number of children injured when travelling in vehicles.

The Road Safety Team are responsible for educating young people and their families on the importance of keeping safe when travelling in a vehicle. Part of this education includes ensuring young people are travelling with correct restraints. Are you aware that 37% of children are in the wrong type of seat for their age and/or height? The Road Safety Team would like to share this car restraint leaflet with you to ensure you know how to always keep your child(ren) safe - in the correct restraint. What have we been learning this week?

Each week, we share what we have been learning in class.

Year 3 - We have had a very busy week. Firstly, our Year 2 friends came over to listen to our story, Jack and the Baked Beanstalk, and then help Mrs Doll and Miss Ball cook beans on toast and eat them. We all had a great time. Our parents and grandparents also came along this week to share our learning so far this half term. Thank you to all of you who came.

In maths this week, we have been learning about measuring length and using rulers to measure accurately. Next week, we are starting our multiplication learning journey. In English, we are writing a set of instructions to create a recipe for beans on toast.

We look forward to seeing all of you at parents' evening next week.

Year 4 - This week in English, we have been learning about adverbs and how to identify and use them in our writing. In maths, we have been comparing amounts of money. In DT, we have been evaluating existing products ready to design and create our own hand puppets.

Next week in English, we will be planning our own complaint letter, using all the features we have been learning about. In maths, we will be adding and subtracting amounts of money. In DT, we will be designing our own hand puppets.

Year 5 - This week in year five we have been investigating prime numbers and factors in maths. In English, we have started to look at how to write an apology letter as Duncan to his lost and abandoned crayons. We have embarked on our Hampshire Illustrated Book Award adventure in guided reading and we have been predicting storylines and exploring vocabulary choices. During our art lessons, we have been building our Egyptian boxes ready to display our sculptures next week. Our yoga journey continues in PE and we have all noticed how much more flexible we are!

Year 6 - This week, in English, we have been learning about the structures and features of an informative speech in preparation for planning and writing our own speeches next week. In Maths, we have been learning how to multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. Next week, we will be developing our written methods of multiplication. In RE, we have been discussing the concept of peace and learning about the importance of Ramadan to Muslims.
