

English

This half term we shall be reading *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* by C.S. Lewis and writing the opening to the story, when Lucy goes through the wardrobe. We shall also be writing a character description of Mr Tumnus.



PSHE

Our PSHE topic is *Changes in Families*. As part of this, we will be considering what makes a family, how families are different and the roles and relationships within them.

Guided Reading

We will be looking at 5 different information books, with a focus on retrieval and vocabulary skills. We will then be voting for our favourite book for the SLS Hampshire Information Book Award.

Electricity

RE

Our RE topic is based around belief within Humanists and The Golden Rule. We will be exploring the meaning of The Golden Rule and why it is important to some people.

Maths

In maths, we will then look at place value with measurement including mass and length. Following on from this, we will be learning about time and fractions.

Science

The children will design, make and evaluate a scene from *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* using an electrical circuit. This will include cutting and joining a range of materials such as wood, plastic and card and incorporating an electrical circuit.
