

Year 5 Spring 1 Curriculum

Maths:

Spring 1 will begin with fractions, decimals and percentages. We will then be using protractors to measure and draw different angles.

Then we will be moving on to adding and subtracting, thinking about the different methods we might use. We will also be adding and subtracting fractions.

Guided Reading:

Our Guided Reading text will be 'Watercress.' We will be focusing on retrieving details from the text and developing our understanding of inference.

RE:

We will be exploring the concept of Wisdom and examining sacred texts in the Islamic and Christian faiths.

French

We will be learning to speak in French about the town we are from and what is in it. We will then move on to discussing our address in French.

PE:

PE will be swimming on **Monday (5SJ)** or **Tuesday (5LP)** with netball and indoor athletics on **Thursday**.

Geography - Coast to Coast

Our topic name this term is 'Coast to Coast!'

We will be learning about coasts and the effect of erosion, particularly focussing on the Jurassic Coast.

As part of our learning unit, we shall also be enjoying a residential trip to Leeson House from 6th - 8th Feb in Swanage.

English:

We are reading 'The Baker by the Sea' before writing our aspirational speeches about growing up, drawing on the experiences and emotions of the characters in the book. We will be focusing on using adverbials of time, and ensuring we are using the correct tense when we write our speeches.

We will be looking at 'economic wellbeing', thinking about how we can make good choices with our money. We will look at budgeting, saving and how to be safe shopping online.

We will also be discussing different careers and thinking about what careers our skills and interests may lead us to choose.
