

Year 6 Spring 1 Curriculum

MATHS:

In maths, we will be learning how to calculate with fractions using all 4 operations. We will also continue to develop our understanding of equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages. We will learn how to convert between different units and solve problems involving mass and capacity. We will learn how to interpret line graphs and pie charts.

COMPUTING

Our computing focus will be on Scratch, which is a coding program. We will be coding the 'sprite' (animal icon) to move around a maze by giving it computing commands in a sequence of code. We will be using directional language and clear instructions to be successful. We will also need to debug our codes when errors occur.

RE:

In RE this half term, we will be learning about Rites of Passage in our own lives and understanding about the importance of the Hajj to Muslims in the religion of Islam.

ART:

In art this term, we will be studying the work of the artist, Sonia Delaunay. We will be using collage to mimic her artistic style.

GUIDED READING:

During Guided Reading this term, we will be reading the book, 'A Different Dog; by Paul Jennings. We will be using a range of reading skills linked to this story.

FRENCH

This half term, we will be focusing on introducing ourselves and learning to tell someone some basic information such as parts of the body, our appearance, how we are feeling and what the matter is.

PSHE:

Our new unit of work is about looking after our health and wellbeing. We will learn about healthy lifestyles and the potential impact of technology on our physical and mental health.



ENGLISH

In English, our new focus text will be the novel 'Holes.' We will be creating a variety of different pieces of writing, including a diary, a letter of complaint, an informal letter, an internal monologue and a non-chronological report.

SCIENCE

Our focus this half term in science is electricity and light. We will be creating circuits and understanding how we draw a circuit and the components scientifically. We will also be recognising how light travels; including how our eyes reflect and absorb light.

PE

Our PE days this half term are **Mondays and Wednesdays.**

We will be focusing on gymnastics and netball.
