During this period of lockdown we thought it would be useful to help navigate you towards some tips to helping with home learning. These may include free resources to help supplement the work that children are set by teachers on Google classroom. We will try and update this information as and when new ideas and approaches come out. The resources supplied are aimed at supplementing and not replacing the work on Google classroom and it is the expectation that children complete the work set by their teacher.

## Using an Xbox or Playstation to access Google Classroom

Families at home are now able to access Google classroom using gaming consoles. To make things easier, you may require a keyboard.

### X Box

1. Plug a keyboard into the Xbox USB slot
2. Go into my games and apps
3. Find Microsoft Edge and select
4. Type in Google classroom and login as you would in school
5. You can then access your work through Google classroom.

### Playstation

1. Identify the Playstation internet browser icon (it is WWW with dots around it)
2. Press the PS4 logo on the controller
3. Go to the library and find options for games and applications
4. Go into applications and you will find the internet browser
5. Type Google classroom into the browser and login as you would in school
6. You can then access your work through Google classroom.
